A Status Conference was held in this case on January 24, 2011. Upon consideration of the representations of the parties, and the entire record herein, it is hereby

ORDERED that this case is referred to the Court's Alternative Dispute Resolution program for a period of 60 days for settlement discussions regarding attorneys' fees; and it is further

ORDERED that, in light of Defendant's position that it has produced all materials required by the Court's Order dated September 24, 2009 [Dkt. No. 90], summary judgment motions shall address (1) the adequacy of Defendant's search, and (2) exemptions claimed by the Defendant; and it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file his Motion for Summary Judgment by **March 15, 2011 at 5 p.m.**; Defendant shall file its Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment by **May 1, 2011 at 5 p.m.**; Plaintiff shall file his Opposition to Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment and Reply

to Defendant's Opposition by **June 1, 2011**; and Defendant shall file its Reply to Plaintiff's Opposition no later than **July 1, 2011**; and it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment shall contain no more than **50 pages** and Defendant's combined Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment shall contain no more than **50 pages**.
