
ORDER

The Parties have submitted a Joint Status Report [Dkt. No. 27] as previously Ordered by the Court. The Government has asked for an extension of the current stay until May 31, 2016. Plaintiff complains that the Department of Justice is close to 45 days past the date all documents were originally due. The Court concludes that it is not unreasonable, given the huge number of documents that may need to be produced, to give the Government an additional month and a half to complete that production.

WHEREFORE, it is this 18th day of April, 2016, hereby

ORDERED, that Defendant shall produce, on a rolling basis, all documents to which Plaintiff is entitled, **no later than May 31, 2016**; and it is further

ORDERED, that, thereafter, the Parties shall submit a further Joint Status Report **no later than August 31, 2016**.
