other UNABOM events and [REDACTED] himself (he is currently 66) and is b6  
outside the age range normally being considered for the UNABOM b7C  
subject.

[REDACTED] has been fully identified, and the information  
provided does not meet the predication to initiate a specific  
suspect investigation. Unless new information is developed b6  
regarding [REDACTED] this will remain unassigned in a suspect dead b7C  
file. Buffalo Division will be advised separately by UTF  
regarding this.
